One final example from 2005 I had a 10 week contract to teach one particular group of students who had all enrolled together for a program of study. At the end of that period the employer asked me to wait unemployed for four weeks till they needed me again. I had to move on.
Apart from the two contracts of 3 months and the one of 10 weeks back in 2005, there are no contracts in the ELICOS industry. A teacher does not expect a contract in that industry it all depends on the business of selling education and students gaining Visas to study in Australia.
